With a goal to enhance Outward Bound's community-based partnerships, we collect and analyze data on program delivery and student outcomes to continuously improve programs and professional learning.

The Domains of Thriving (DoT) framework and tool (right) combines Outward Bound's 60 years of experience facilitating life-changing experiences with the latest insight and research on social-emotional development. The (DoT) highlights the four areas of human development that are impacted on an Outward Bound course: Courage, Belonging, Reflection, and Physical Engagement.
